He currently serves as a Director on the ASEE Engineering Deans Council Executive Committee, Chair of the Ohio Engineering Deans Council, and member of the Grand Challenges Scholars Program Interim Executive Committee, the Toledo Society of Professional Engineers Board, the Engineers Foundation of Ohio Board, and Better Business Bureau of NW Ohio and SW Michigan Board.
